After being hospitalized for 16 days, Mr. Honeycutt was ready to begin his Rehabilitation at Kentmere on 1/28/20. Previously, he was living at home with his wife in a 2 story home. He was independent with dressing/ bathing and ambulating in the community using a walker. He was driving and working about 30 hours at his sports memorabilia store at the farmers market, where he told us he is known as "Crazy Jack".

Upon coming to Kentmere, he was requiring about 50% help with lower body dressing and 25 % with upper body dressing. He needed hands on steadying assistance to get up from a chair and only could walk about 30 feet. On the functional reach test, he scored only 4 inches (13 is normal) and on a chair rise test he completed 4 reps (normal is 10 reps) Both these tests indicate he was at a high risk for falls. After completing rehab, he is

now once again independent with dressing/bathing and can now get up from a chair on his own. He is walking independently up to 350'. As for falls, he no longer scores at

risk for falling. He scored 13 on the functional reach and now can complete 10 reps of sit to stand.

Way to go "Crazy Jack" You did it!!!
